All fees are doubled for non-parishioners.

- The Parish Council will only deal with registered undertakers with reference to an interment of a body or cremated remains.
- Any excess spoil must be removed from site by the grave digger
- Headstones remain the responsibility / property of the purchaser and they are expected to keep the headstone in good repair.
- Please note that the maximum size for a memorial on an ashes plot is 12" x 12", if larger memorial is required two plots should be purchased.
